Steve with Troy, our expert Wrangler

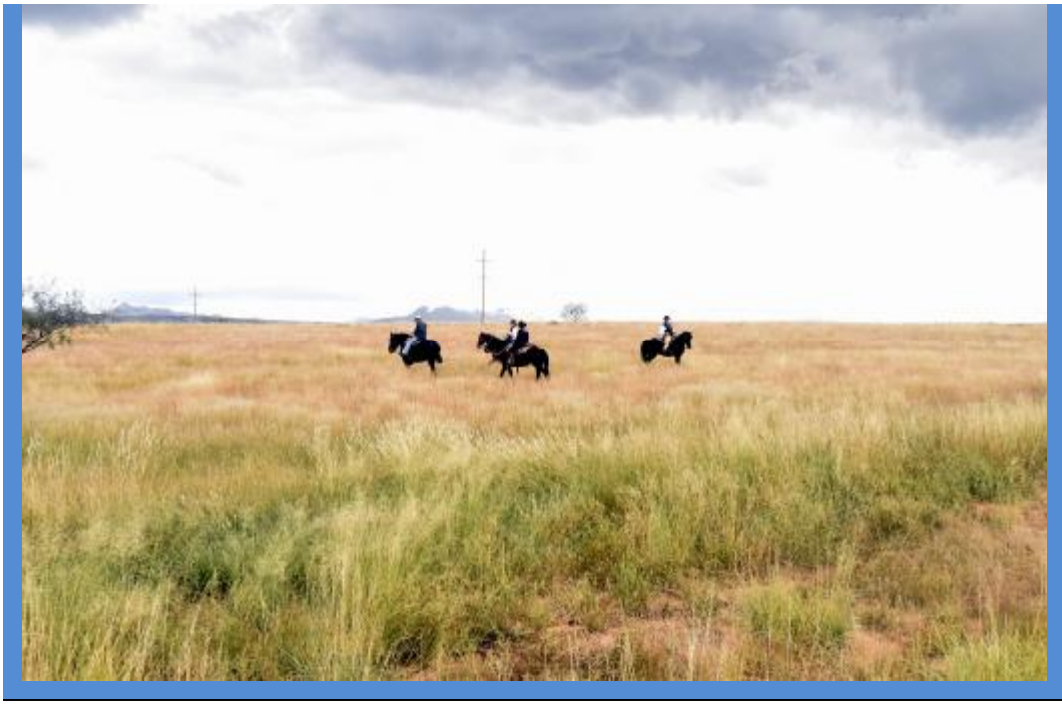




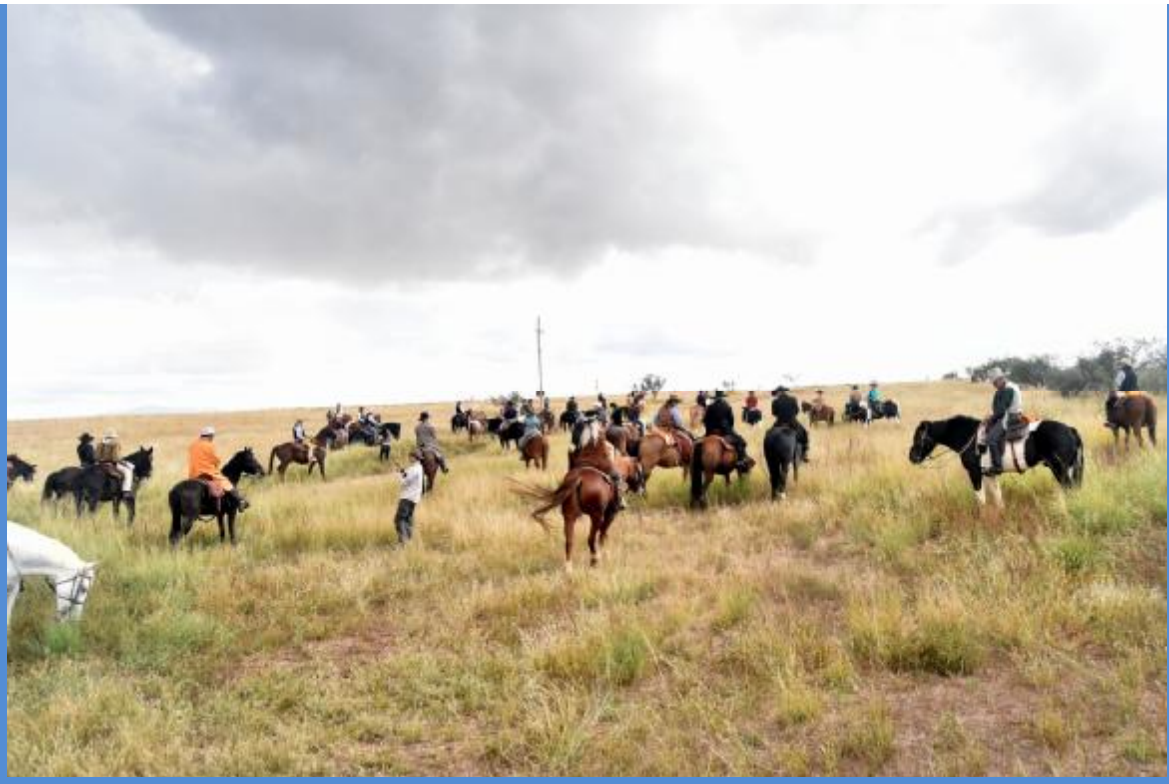
I did not realize this until editing the photos. On the left is Indy, on the right is Annie. Indy Annie



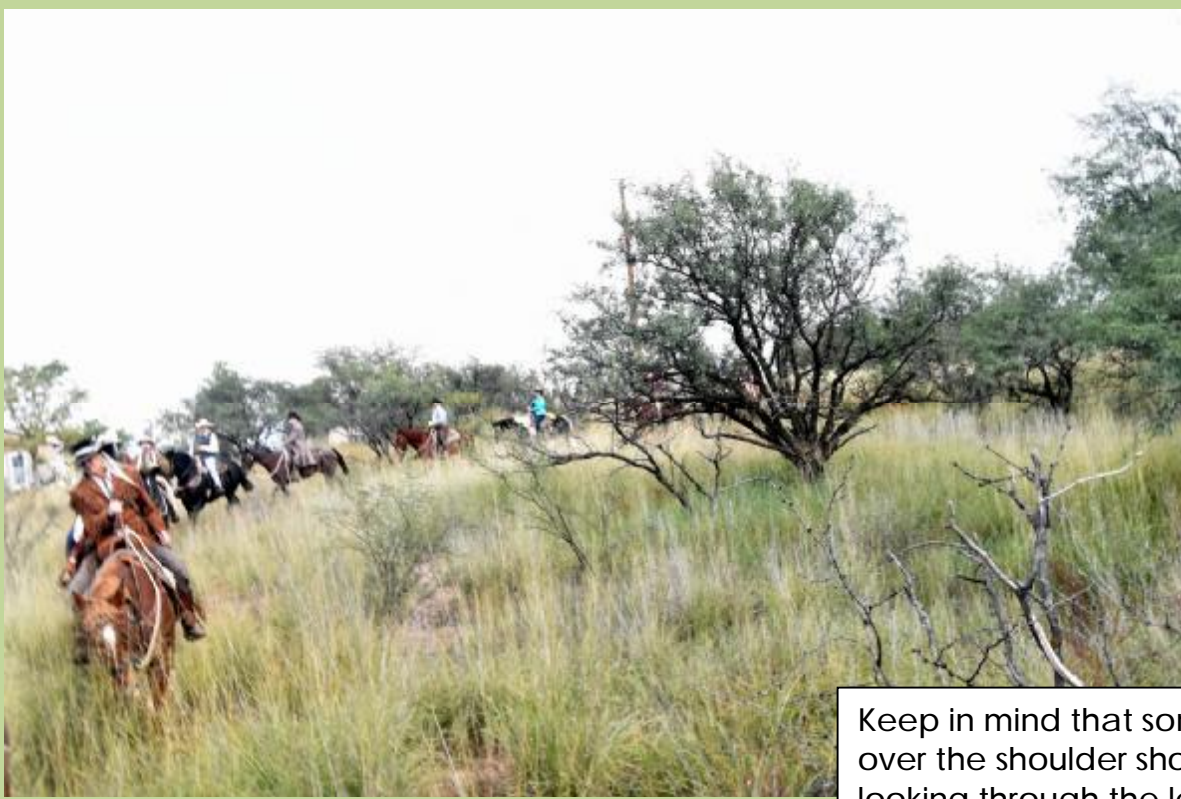
Can you guess why we had this picture taken?
