In Search of Eldorado

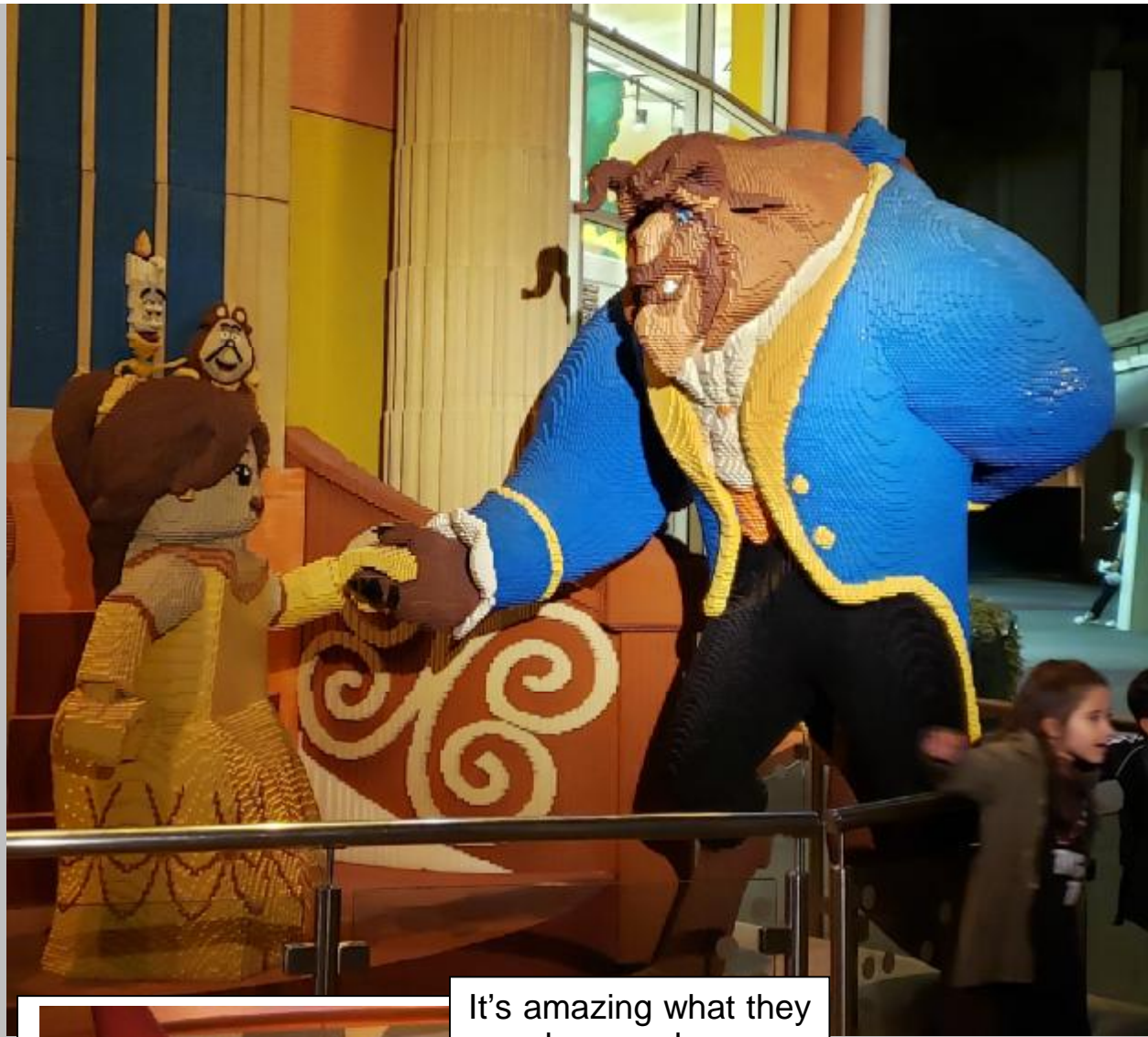
