Bonanza Creek Ranch is an all-inclusive film location nestled in the foothills near Santa Fe, New Mexico. The ranch is spread out over several thousands of acres and features 2 ponds, one movie town and 2 home sets. More than 130 movies have been filmed here since 1955 including The Man from Laramie (starring Jimmy Stewart), Butch Cassidy and the Sundance Kid, Easy Rider, The Cheyenne Social Club (Jimmy Stewart and Henry Fonda), The Cowboys (John Wayne), The Sacketts, The Legend of the Lone Ranger, Silverado, Young Guns, Lonesome Dove, Walker, Texas Ranger, The Missing, Into the West, 3:10 to Yuma, Wild Hogs and Cowboys & Aliens. As you will see later on, Justice, to be released later this year, still had production trailers and dressing rooms on site.

The Ranch is currently booked for all of 2016, so we were lucky to get our two days.

















Below - We really roughed it. A 1-holer for a group of 40-50. And no door. JK

QUIET ON THE SET!!






John Chisum and I moseyed on down to the Sheriff's Office.

Far left is Sharon, who we have seen in several of the photos above. I have not met the young ladies on her right or below yet.



Run rabbit, run!!






Left is the Arizona Kid dressed as a cavalry sergeant for a different scene.

Below - The ladies wait with Larry and his team.




Boo!! The good guys arrive in Brimstone. Boo!





Steve saying his lines flawlessly, as always.




The Peacemakers show their superior numbers. Heck, they outnumber us 3 to 1. Who do you expect to win?
